## Chemical control

Control of anthracnose on susceptible mango cultivars and in conducive environments requires periodic fungicide sprays. The timing and frequency of applications are critical for adequate disease control. Sprays should begin when panicles first appear and continue at the recommended intervals until fruits are about 2 to 4 cm long (Figure 38).

There are also foliar fungicides registered for control of mango anthracnose, among them are clarified neem oil and Kocide 101 which is copper based and wettable sulphur
