1. RESEARCH SCIENTIST (SEED SCIENCE): KEFRI 7

a) Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist in research problem identification that address provisioning of quality tree seed;
- Participate in conceptualization, formulation, design and implementation of multidisciplinary research projects in Seed Science;
- Undertake research in Seed Science;
- Verify results of seed quality tests and compile reports;
- Publish and disseminate research findings;
- Ensure cleanliness and safety in the laboratory and safe disposal of waste;
- Identification of consumables required for undertaking seed quality assurance and research and assisting in their procurement;
- Supervise and mentor junior staff, interns, students on attachment;
- Host technical and non-technical visitors;
- Prepare and sign KEFRI staff performance contract with your supervisor;
- Participate in implementing relevant ISO standards in Research and Development;
- Participate in compilation of departmental quarterly and annual reports; and
- Any other duty as assigned from time to time.

- Clean laboratory apparatus, equipment working and working surfaces;
- Participate in publications of technical documents;
- Carry out demonstrations for clients and visitors;
- Train and supervise students on attachment and staff in the unit;
- Prepare and sign KEFRI staff performance contract with your supervisor;
- Participate in implementing relevant ISO standards in Research and Development;
- Participate in compilation of departmental quarterly and annual reports; and
